

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Montana:

Political Code,

Section 1. That Article II, of Chapter VI, of Part III, Title III, of the Political Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding a section to be known as Section 1745 to read as follows:

School census,

Section 1745. It shall be the duty of the County Superintendent of Schools to prepare and transmit within thirty days after he receives the school census from the district clerk, a copy of the census showing the name, sex, age and date of birth of each child under seventeen years of age residing in the county together with the names of the parents or guardians of such children to the Commissioner of the Bureau of Agriculture, Labor and Industry. No County Superintendent shall be paid his salary for the last month in his official year until he presents to the County Commissioners the receipt of the Commissioner of the Bureau of Agriculture, Labor and Industry for such annual census report.

Penalty.

Section 2. This act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Governor.

CHAPTER 18.

An Act to amend Section 1192 of the Penal Code of the State of Montana, making it unlawful to, wrongfully and without authority, use the name, title of officers, insignia, ritual or ceremonies of certain Orders and Societies, and providing punishment for the violation of the provisions of this Act.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Montana:

Section I. That Section 1192 of the Penal Code of the State of Montana be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read, as follows:

Section 1192: Any person who wilfully wears the badge of the Grand Army of the Republic, the insignia, badge or rosette of the Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States, or of the Military Order of Foreign Wars of the United States, or the badge or button of the United Spanish War Veterans, or the Order of Patrons of Husbandry, or the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the United States of America, of the Order of the Knights of Pythias or Labor Organizations, or any Society, Order or Organization of ten years standing in the State of Montana, or use the name to obtain aid or assistance within this State, or wilfully uses the name of such society, order or organization, the title of its officers, or its insignia, rituals or ceremonies, unless entitled to use or wear the same under the constitution and by-laws, rules and regulations of such Order, or of such Society, Order or Organization, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction, shall be punished by imprisonment for a term not to exceed ninety days in the county jail, or a fine not to exceed two hundred and no-100—(\$200.00) dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment, provided this shall not apply to the wives, daughters, sisters or mothers of members of these orders who are in good standing.
