

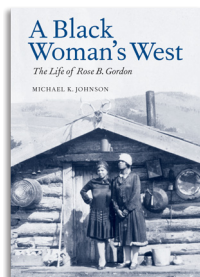

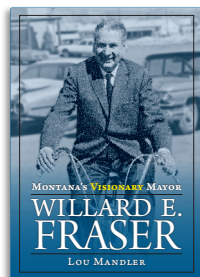

## New! Montana's Visionary Mayor

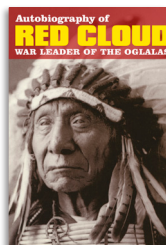
